

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(BLETCHINGDON, KIRTLINGTON AND SHIPTON-ON-CHERWELL AREAS)  
(SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\***

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order – in order to help improve road safety on local roads following concerns raised by the parish – is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** throughout Shipton-on-Cherwell, replacing the majority of the existing 30mph speed limit on those roads east of & excluding the A4260 Banbury Road in the process, leading out to the following point:

- The unnamed road from Shipton-on-Cherwell to the A4260 Banbury Road – to a point 355 metres east of its junction with the A4260 Banbury Road.

The 355 metres section of 30mph speed limit will remain as a ‘buffer’ limit from the A4260 Banbury Road.

Additionally, a **20mph speed limit** is proposed in place of part of the 40mph speed on the A4095 Bunkers Hill adjacent to the residential properties, from a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with Field View Lane, north-eastwards for a distance of 345 metres.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Bletchington, Kirtlington and Shipton-on-Cherwell Areas) (Speed Limits) Order 2022 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
